

Albert O. Shar, Ph.D.

Dr. Shar joined the Foundation in September, 2002, as the vice president of Information Technology. He is responsible for development and delivery of technology to support RWJF operations and programmatic direction. He was previously responsible for IT Research and Architecture at the RW Johnson Pharmaceutical Institute, a Johnson & Johnson company. Prior to that Dr. Shar held the positions of director of technology services, University of Pennsylvania Health System and executive director, University of Pennsylvania School of Medicine. He has held research and teaching professorships at the University of Pennsylvania, University of New Hampshire, Swiss Federal Polytechnic Institute and University of Colorado. Dr. Shar is the author of over thirty scholarly publications in medical informatics, computer science and pure and applied mathematics.

Dr. Shar received his Ph.D. from the University of Pennsylvania, his M.A. from Fordham University, and his B.A. from Brandeis University.
